NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

The Regatta is open to all OTB boats and Trailable yachts.

Entries will be accepted at registration or pre-entry can be made online at www.bendigo.yachting.org.au.

Registration will be in the foyer of the Bendigo Yacht Club.

3. FEES

Adults = \$60 Regatta per boat / \$10 per race

Under 18 = \$30 Regatta per boat / \$5 per race

4. SCHEDULE

Registration:

Friday 08:00 – 12:00

Racing:

Friday 13:00 – Session 1

Saturday 09:30 – Session 2 (finish will be in time to watch the AFL Grand Final)

Sunday 09:30 – Session 3 (no warning signal after 14:00)

Maximum of 3 races per session

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Regatta Sailing Instructions will be available at registration and posted on the notice board in the BeYC clubhouse foyer.

6. VENUE

Bendigo Yacht Club, Sunset Drive, Eppalock. Racing will be conducted in the Kimbolton Pool, Lake Eppalock in the vicinity of Bendigo Yacht Club.

7. SCORING

3 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

8. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the Regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the regatta.

9. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$5M per event or the equivalent.
