


Last year Brian set about building a new one using Jack's plans and named the boat in honour of his Dad, which Jack is quietly thrilled about.

Pack a picnic lunch and find a spot on a boat – yours, a club boat, a friend's boat, one of the cruiser's boats or the rescue boat.


